Parent Survey Responses

Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete our Parent Survey. We value your views and opinions enormously and these help support our future decisions.

We would like you to share with you some of our highlights:

- 94% of parents were happy with the procedures we put into place in response to Covid19.
- 89% of parents said they felt the measures in place kept their child safe.
- 90% of parents were happy with the information we have provided around Covid19.
- 97% of parents agreed that their child was well supported through any period of isolation.
- 93% of parents feel their child's wellbeing was supported whilst in school.
- 94% of parents believed their child was happy to be back in school.

"The support was amazing - at least twice a day contact with the teacher as well as support available as required and good level of work to keep my child occupied."

"The support was great, school did practice session before starting live lessons."

In response to the survey, we have requested all parents and staff wear face coverings on drop off and collection times as some parents raised concerns about this. This was also in response to Staffordshire being under tier 3 restrictions and to ensure we keep our community as safe as possible. We have continued to stagger the start and finish times to avoid congestion at entry and exit points. This will continue to be monitored next term.

In addition to this, we have timetabled sessions with the children in school so they are familiar with the online platform in preparation for any class closures. This hopefully reduces any upset for children if they have to face online lessons and increases their familiarity with the programmes.
