Tillington Manor Primary School – Sport Premium Budget

Overview

The Sport Premium budget is received with the school budget at the beginning of the financial year. In addition to the initial allocations in March there have been allocations which have been received at the start of the academic year in September. The receipt of additional funding has necessitated an up-date to our Sports Premium Budget.

There has been an incredible change within Sporting provision across Tillington Manor. This has seen staff gain valuable training and the children being able to access and use new and improved equipment, some of which had not been replaced for many years. The additional money received has allowed us to restock our P.E. store and has given staff the ability to teach a much enriched sporting curriculum – staff now have access to brand new equipment for all major sports.

We are continuing to develop sport within our school and our aim which we have achieved was to secure permanent physical equipment to support children in EYFS and children with SEND. Through these initiatives we will encourage all children to be actively involved in sport at Tillington Manor.

Following on from the academic year 18/19, at the renewal of the budget in April 2019, we had a surplus of £10,667 which was unspent due to budgeting, knowing we had a final bill for an external provider and because we wanted to "save" for our EYFS equipment. This was added to the budget for the 2019/2020 academic year, which was further boosted by an additional allocation of £16,000 plus an additional £2510, which includes the grant for 2018/2019. This put us therefore at £29,177. We intend to use the money for coaching, CPD commitments and to further improve the sporting infrastructure at Tillington Manor Primary School.

Cricket Sporting Provision – Staffordshire Cricket	£600	Following on from the success of England this summer, children at Tillington loved to play cricket and really showed an enthusiasm towards the world cup and wanted to learn more about the sport. Staffordshire CC will be coming in to school to work with children in Spring I and Summer 2 this year to get children in to the sport in school and externally.	Children will be able to gain experience, skills and match experience with experienced, professional coaches. We aim to work with Staffordshire CC to enter competitions and to encourage more children to take up the sport externally. Children will build a range of skills and apply these within sessions against peers and inter-school competitions.

Gymnastics Training CPD	£225	This 2 day course has given a staff member a gymnastics teachers award and knowledge of teaching gym skills in school. It will also enable us to deliver the British Gymnastics Proficiency awards in school.	The PE lead will be able to provide "British Gymnastics" quality assured experiences for all children. We will also be able to run a Gymnastics club which will run alongside British Gymnastics.
Sporting Equipment	£2,000	Outdated equipment meant staff were struggling to teach certain sports due to not having full sets of equipment, or kit which was good enough to use. As in the classroom, resources are needed and our P.E. Store was in need of sorting and reordering. Working with staff we were able to completely restock our store.	Sporting equipment to ensure coverage of a broad sporting curriculum has been purchased. Children are now able to access a wider range of sporting activities.
Sporting Events	£650	Transport and administration costs to outer school sporting events.	We run various clubs across the year such as Cross Country, Athletics and Cricket. The money set aside helps to pay for transport costs to ensure all children can take part in these sport activities. This enhances experiences for a range of children.

Extra- Curricular Sports Funding.	£1000	By budgeting for sports clubs within schools, we aim to remove any limitations on clubs available to our students. This will allow staff to purchase any new sporting equipment needed for their specialist clubs which we currently may not have or be able to provide children with additional sporting experiences.	Children will have their extra-curricular clubs based around specialist sports rather than "what is available", meaning the range and opportunities available for our pupils will increase. This will allow children to experience a much wider variety of sports/sporting skills.
Trial Markings – Active SEND	£1000	At Tillington we have a high level of SEND need amongst the children, who would benefit from a range of provision to help them to channel their thoughts, anxieties and energy and use them in a productive and active way. The provision will consist of sporting thermos- plastic markings	It is hoped the provision will provide those children, who maybe struggle with the rules or understanding of a sporting game, with access to active and physical education.
EYFS Playground Equipment	£I5,000	EYFS is the start of school life. If children do not get into routine here then it can be a struggle to teach it further on through their education. We feel it is vital that we provide outdoor equipment to our youngest children to inspire them to love the outdoors and being active.	The outdoor "Jungle Gym" we will get will excite, inspire and motivate children to climb, swing, run, jump and work together as a team, increasing current activity levels and setting a solid base for sports later in life.
