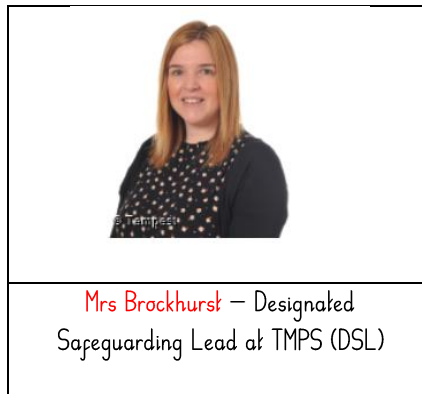






Concerned about the safety of a child?
